




Posting in Piazza from a Phone



To Start: Download App and join class following link provided by your instructor (on Moodle or via email).





Check that you're happy with global settings (apply to all your courses).

Posting in Piazza from a Phone




Do you want to get email summaries of: Everything? Nothing? Only some posts?

How often do you want those emails?


If you're getting push notifications on your phone, you probably don't want email notifications about the same thing. If you don't like push notifications, opt into email notifications here.




Click on the class name to get here. Click the set of vertical dots for options.






Filter to quickly find posts of interest.

Posting options are down here.




Give your post a title to help other readers. Then type a question. LaTeX is supported if you want to write equations that look nice. When done, click "NEXT".


